CODE OF CONDUCT POLICY**

4.1

Welcome to the Deborah Rawson Memorial library. Our goal is to offer the best service possible to all library visitors of all ages in an inviting and comfortable environment.

Each person can help by following these Rules of Conduct that have been adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Deborah Rawson Memorial library in best efforts to promote a safe, attractive and orderly atmosphere and to assure every person's constitutional right to use and have reasonable access to all library materials.

1. Children aged 8 and under must be under the direct and constant supervision of a person 18 years of age or older. *The library staff cannot assume responsibility for the safety, wellbeing and supervision of unattended children. Parents and caregivers are responsible for the safety and supervision of their children at all times.*
2. Inappropriate behavior which disturbs other library users or library staff is not permitted.
3. The following are not permitted on library property:
 - Weapons
 - Use of tobacco, alcohol or illegal substances
 - Threatening or obscene language
 - Barefoot- shirtless
 - Soliciting of sales
 - Fighting, running, or rowdy behavior
 - Skateboarding
 - Gambling
 - Harassment, intimidations, disturbance or threatening any person by word or by act.
4. Theft, damage or destruction of library property is a crime and will be prosecuted

The library reserves the right to remove any person whose behavior is disruptive, is inappropriate for a library environment, or interferes with the use of the library by others.
